# Botnvatnet Buttress

## LOCATION/ACCESS:

- » From the parking at the Skalands tunnel (North entrance) follow the concrete tunnel along the Botnvatnet lake (161m) to the bottom of the buttress and routes in 15 min. While overshadowed by Stormoa and Hesten this crag has many good lines with quick access and easy descent by the gully to the south of the crag (Botnvatnet means Cirque Lake).

## LINES (LEFT TO RIGHT):

- » Cirque: WI4, 4 pitches, 170m (1 March 2019) by Micha Rinn (Germany) and Simon Richardson (Scotland)
- » Arena: WI4, 180m (2 March 2019) by John Higham and John Hutchinson (Scotland)
- » Cockpit: WI3, 180m (28 February 2019) by John Higham and John Hutchinson (Scotland)
- » Globe: WI2, 190m (1 March 2019) by John Higham and John Hutchinson (Scotland)

## DECENT:

- » Decent on easy terrain clockwise down to the buttress in 30 min.
